Many government departments/institutions have sought clarification on the details of devices/equipments that can be classified as "Computer Peripherals". Government have examined the matter in detail and hereby clarified that the term "Computer Peripherals" includes :-

- Any Input device which is used to send data to the computer (mouse, keyboards, etc.)
- Any Output device which provides data out from the computer (monitors, printers, etc.)
- Any Storage, which stores data processed by the computer (hard drives, flash drives, etc.)
- Any device used for networking like Routers, Switches etc.,
- Other examples of peripherals are image scanners, tape drives, microphones, loudspeakers, web cams, digital cameras, Power Backup Equipments like UPS etc.
